



Lime Rock Park 2021 Operating Procedures

We at Lime Rock Park are proud to be a State of Connecticut certified COVID-19 / Coronavirus prevention facility # BRC-00008806.

Health and Disinfection Protocol – Lime Rock Park racetrack, works closely with The Torrington Area Health District and The State of Connecticut to provide a safe, secure and healthy environment for our guests, employees and community. We continue to closely monitor local, state and government policy changes, Centers for Disease Control (CDC) guidelines, federal / government mandates, and public health advancements daily. These guidelines describe in detail the necessary and appropriate steps being taken to operate in a safe, secure, and healthy manner.

Purpose: To create a safe, secure, and healthy environment, thereby reducing the possibility of transmittal of the COVID-19 / Coronavirus. This is achieved via physical distancing of a minimum of 6 feet (2 meters) apart at all times (unless all from the same family unit or same household), close monitoring of all building occupant capacities and keeping unrented buildings closed except for bathrooms and Porta-Johns. Under current guidelines, at no time or place outdoors no more than two hundred (200) people can gather or congregate in one open area section. Facemasks or cloth face coverings should continue to be properly worn in public at all times except when actively eating or drinking. Lime Rock Park reserves the right to require that guests not respecting these guidelines leave the property.

Chalet Buildings: Occupancy of all buildings will be restricted to 50% capacity at any time during facility rental. If a building is not directly rented, the building will remain closed to the public other than the use of the designated restrooms. Housekeeping will be available to clean and sanitize all areas and common touch points using CDC approved methods and EPA approved disinfectant and cleansers. There will be health and hygiene signage reminders throughout the facility.

Self-screening: All employees and guests are to self-screen before arriving at Lime Rock Park for any of the following new or worsening signs or symptoms of, or contact with possible COVID 19:

- Cough
- Fever
- Shortness of breath
- Persistent chest pain
- Bluish lips or face
- Feeling feverish or temp over 100 Degrees
- Known close contact with a lab confirmed person with COVID-19
- Getting chills
- Repeated shaking with chills
- Diarrhea
- Muscle pain
- Headache
- Sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell

Park Entry: All attendees will be required to enter via the 60 White Hollow entrance. Prior to the scheduled event, the track renters will provide us with a list of pre-approved attendees. Upon entering the facility, all pre-approved attendees will stop at the guest services office and be checked in. Unless specifically authorized by the rental client, additional vehicles with spectators or visitors will not be permitted entry. No one will exit any vehicles during this process. The guest service gate attendant will provide the occupants with 2 clipboards, one with the Lime Rock Park liability waiver and one with the Lime Rock Park COVID-19 waiver, to be signed as to allow entry to Lime Rock Park.

Park Restriction: If any guests, visitors or employees have come in contact with an infected person or are experiencing any signs or symptoms related to COVID-19 / Coronavirus such as cough, fever, shortness of breath, persistent chest pain, bluish lips or face, getting chills, or repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, diarrhea, new loss of taste or smell, you may have been exposed to COVID-19 / Coronavirus in the last 2 to 14 days and are asked not to enter Lime Rock Park. Any such individual should also avoid contact with any older adults and people of any age who are at risk or have any serious underlying medical conditions making them at risk for any reasons. If alerted to a presumptive case of COVID-19 at Lime Rock Park, Lime Rock will contact Torrington Area Health District and follow the appropriate actions.

Hand Sanitizing Stations: Hand sanitizing stations will be located throughout Lime Rock Park. There will also be hand sanitizing stations at the fuel pumps, air station, all bathrooms, Porta-Johns, base of the Tower, EMS and located at concessions stands. It is recommended that everyone, guests, visitors, and employees be reminded to not touch their faces, avoid physical contact with others and always maintain physical distancing of 6 feet (2 meters) unless all from the same family unit. There will be health and hygiene reminders throughout the facility.

Minimum Recommended Protocols: These protocols are not a limit on the health protocols that individuals may adopt. Individuals are encouraged to adopt additional protocols consistent with their specific needs and circumstances to help protect their health and safety. The virus that causes COVID-19 can be spread to others by infected persons who have few or no symptoms. Even if an infected person is only mildly ill, the people they spread it to may become seriously ill or even die, especially if that person is 65 or older with pre-existing health conditions that place them at higher risk. Because of the hidden nature of this threat, everyone should rigorously follow the practices specified in these protocols, all of which facilitate a safe environment. The virus that causes COVID-19 is still circulating in our communities. Lime Rock Park will continue to observe practices that protect everyone, including those who are most vulnerable. Please note, public health guidance cannot anticipate every unique situation. Individuals should stay informed and take actions based on common sense and wise judgment that will protect health and support economic revitalization.

Flagging Stations: Attendees are not permitted access to manned Flagger stations. HPDE instructors are permitted to observe their students, but from a safe track side location, provided they maintain a distance of at least 25 feet from any manned Flagger station.

Flagging Staff: Flaggers on stations will stay on stations and are always in radio communications with EMS. Equipment exchange for flaggers will take place with a designated flagger meeting and a designated EMS representative outside the EMS building and practicing proper 6-foot physical distancing.

Attendees Responsibility: Attendee responsibility under these circumstances are as follows:

1. No personal contact at all, with anyone, (unless you are all from the same family unit).
2. Always maintain 6-foot (2 meter) social distancing, (unless all from the same family unit).
3. If such distancing is not feasible, other measures such as face covering, hand hygiene, cough etiquette, cleanliness and sanitation should be rigorously practiced.
4. Bring and wear own masks and latex or similar type gloves.
5. Bring own writing implements for signing waivers, forms etc.
6. Frequent hand washing is requested while at Lime Rock Park.
7. Bring own sanitizer and or sanitizing wipes.
8. Lime Rock Park requests strict and proper adherence to these requirements.
9. If Lime Rock Park is alerted to a presumptive case of COVID-19 during visit, Lime Rock Park will contact Torrington Health District and follow the appropriate actions recommended.

Photography: Photographers are allowed at Lime Rock Park if affiliated with the rental client and their names are clearly printed on the attendance list. Orange identification vests must be signed out at EMS and must always be worn when working. Photographers are permitted to capture on-track vehicles and activity but are not to take photos of paddock parking or physical gatherings and when trackside must maintain a 25-foot distance from all Flagger stations.

Bathrooms: Men's, Ladies' and the Handicap/Family bathroom are in A-Paddock and are open for usage. No more than three (3) people should be using the Men's and Ladies bathrooms at one time and will respect 6-foot social distancing (2 meters). The Handicap/Family bathroom is for designated usage only. There will also be Porta-Johns throughout Lime Rock Park for use. Dependent upon specific activity requirements, the bathroom facilities in the Infield and Lime Rock Chalets may be opened, but these buildings would not be available for other purpose or gathering of any type. All bathrooms and Porta-Johns are checked, cleaned, and disinfected frequently by employees available to clean and sanitize all areas and common touch points throughout the day using CDC approved methods and EPA approved disinfectant and cleansers. When using restrooms please always maintain proper social distancing. There will be hand sanitizing stations located in each bathroom and inside each Porta-John.

EMS / Emergency Services Dept.: EMS personnel are located infield at the EMS building trackside, and according to the State of CT OEMS dept., are not considered a part of any group as they are first responders. The EMS building is locked down and only EMS personnel are allowed in and out to maintain its integrity. In the event of an accident or emergency on track, only EMS personnel will respond and if need be transporting the involved person to EMS for further evaluation. They can be reached at 860-435-5008 or by flagging station staff via 2-way radio.

Food / Catering: Food is available, prepared in Lime Rock's sanitary kitchens which have been inspected by the Health Department. Food will be dispensed from the open-air A-Paddock concession stand for take-away within the Park or limited seating in an outside dining area. All concession areas, limited seating areas and food prep areas will be cleaned and sanitized continually through operating hours as well as a deep cleaning at the end of each day. Hand sanitizing stations are located throughout the concession areas. Be mindful of always maintaining a distance of 6 feet (2 meters) while picking up food and while in the concession area.

Hand Washing - Correct hygiene and frequent handwashing with soap is vital to help combat the spread of virus. All Lime Rock Park employees have been instructed to wash their hands, or use sanitizer when a sink is not available, every 60 minutes (for 20 seconds) and after any of the following activities: using the restroom, sneezing, touching the face, blowing the nose, cleaning, sweeping, mopping, smoking, eating, drinking, entering, and leaving through doorways, going on break and before or after starting a shift.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) - Appropriate PPE, face coverings and gloves, will be worn by all employees based on their role and responsibilities and any direct contact with attendees with adherence to state or local regulations and guidance. Training on how to properly use and dispose of all PPE will be conducted with employees.

Facility Health Protocols:

- Regularly and frequently clean and disinfect any regularly touched surfaces, such as doorknobs, tables, chairs, and restrooms.
- Disinfect all areas and common touch points.
- Make hand sanitizer, disinfecting wipes, soap and water, or similar disinfectant available to employees and customers.
- Place readily visible signage at the business to remind everyone of best hygiene practices.
- Department Heads shall ensure office suites are properly cleaned and disinfected each day.
- All Common areas shall be closed when not in use.
- Departments that provide counter service will have barrier screens installed to separate visitors from employees.
